OPERATING AND FINANCIAL REVIEW

The principal activities of the Company are margin lending and cash deposit businesses.

Since the end of the previous financial year, the Company's parent entity, BFG, has paid a premium for an insurance policy for the benefit of the directors, officers, company secretaries and senior executives of BFG and its controlled entities. In accordance with commercial practice, the policy prohibits disclosure of the nature of insurance or amount of the premium.

Bell Potter Capital Limited (the "Company") is domiciled in Australia. The address of the Company's registered office is Level 29, 101 Collins Street, Melbourne, VIC. The condensed consolidated interim financial statements of the Company comprise of the Company and its subsidiaries (the "Group" or "Consolidated Entity") for the half year ended 30 June 2015 and auditor's report thereon.

Bell Potter Capital Limited is a company limited by shares, incorporated in Australia.

The principal activities of the Company are margin lending and cash deposit businesses.

L STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

The condensed consolidated interim financial report has been prepared in accordance with AASB 134 Interim Financial Reporting and the Corporations Act 2001.

The condensed consolidated interim financial report does not include all of the information required for a full annual financial report, and should be read in conjunction with the consolidated annual financial report of the Group as at and for the year ended 31 December 2014.

The condensed consolidated interim financial report was approved by the Board of Directors on 11 August 2014.

2 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Other than described below the accounting policies applied by the Group in this consolidated interim financial report are consistent with those applied by the Group in its consolidated financial report as at and for the year ended 31 December 2014.

3 ESTIMATES

The preparation of the condensed consolidated interim financial reports requires management to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of accounting policies and the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, income and expense. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

In preparing this condensed consolidated interim financial report, the significant judgments made by management in applying the Group's accounting policies and the key sources of estimation and uncertainty were the same as those that applied to the consolidated financial report as at and for the year ended 31 December 2014. During the period, management reassessed estimates in respect of:

Impairment of loans and advances

The Company assesses impairment of all loans at each reporting date by evaluating conditions specific to the Group and to the particular asset that may lead to impairment. In the Directors' opinion, no such impairment exists beyond that provided at 30 June 2015.

4 FINANCIAL RISK MANAGEMENT

All aspects of the Group's financial risk management objectives and policies are consistent with that disclosed in the consolidated financial report as at and for the year ended 31 December 2014.
